National Baptist Fellowship of Churches L.C. Cook Scholarship Criteria

The applicant must:

- I. Be a graduating senior in which the year that they are applying for the L.C. Cook Scholarship.
- II. An active member of the NMBFC for two years or more prior to applying for the L.C. Cook Scholarship.
- III. Be an active member of his/her home church.
- IV. The applicant must be an active participant of the NMBFC (The Pastor has to financially represent their church according to the NMBFC guidelines).
- V. Submit an essay of no more than 500 words on why he/she deserves the L.C. Cook Scholarship from the National Missionary Baptist Fellowship of Churches.
- VI. Be planning to attend a Four year accredited College/University or an accredited Junior College. The monetary amount of the Scholarship for all other schools (i.e. Trade/Technical Schools) will be decided by the Scholarship Committee upon individual need.
- VII. Submit a copy of the acceptance letter from the College/University in which he/she will be attending.
- VIII. Submit a High School Transcript reflecting their GPA.
- IX. Have a letter of recommendation from the Pastor or Youth Director of the Church.
- X. Follow all instructions on application, which includes the attachment of all required information.
- XI. Mail all four corresponding names, found at the end of the application, each a copy of all required documents including essay.
